A perfect balance of bright fresh fruit flavors and acidity, we believe that this wine excels for thinking outside the box. The Cuvée Brut is not Prosecco, by definition, but it will satisfy the pickiest Prosecco fans. Creating a fruit-forward, dry style wine featuring the prosecco grape, Glera, Fabrizio adds a special touch with the Pinot Bianco. The Pinot Bianco adds weight and texture to the brightness of the Glera and rounds out the flavor profile expressing mostly stone and orchard fruits with a splash of citrus.

The Cuvée Brut is a rebel, defying expectation and the laws of region to deliver the best possible sparkling wine at an unbeatable value! Sure, there are less expensive "mass-produced" bubbles out there but not with the integrity and flavor that Fabrizio provides. This is one bottle of inexpensive bubbles that won't give you a headache.

VARIETAL NOTES

Glera is an ancient grape that has been cultivated in the Veneto, around the town of Prosecco in northern Italy since the times of the Roman Empire. It is considered one of the most important indigenous Italian grapes because of its popularity of the Prosecco wines throughout Italy and abroad.

Pinot Bianco is a grape widely planted throughout Italy's northeast corner. Very popular in the Alto-Adige and Friuli. A mutation from Pinot Noir, Pinot Bianco gets compared to Chardonnay for its body and its transparent character. It is distinguished in flavor by an element of smokiness and a little bit nutty.
