While most wine drinkers have experienced Syrah or Shiraz, this expression from Sicily exhibits character and flavors that can only be developed from this Mediterranean-influenced terroir.

The deep ruby red color is alluring in the glass, a sneak peek of the charismatic flavors you are about to experience -- a harmonious combination of dark cherries, blackberries and blueberries. Earth tones pay homage to the land, slight leather and tobacco are followed by a spicy finish of bacon and black pepper.

VARIETAL NOTES

Syrah is a dark-skinned grape grown throughout the world and used primarily to produce powerful red wines. Aroma characters can range from violets to berries (usually dark as opposed to red), chocolate, espresso and black pepper. No one aroma can be called "typical" though blackberry and pepper are often noticed. With time in the bottle these "primary" notes are en-joined by earthy or savory "tertiary" notes of leather and truffle. "Secondary" flavor and aroma notes are those associated with several things, including winemakers' practices (such as oak barrel and yeast regimes), and land terroir qualities.

FOOD PAIRING

Bold wine, bold foods. Rich, savory stews, braised meat dishes in hearty pan jus, braised lamb shank.
