The Veneto's best sunny hillsides are chosen for these Pinot Grigio vineyards. This is Pinot Grigio with excellent body and imminent approachability. Light straw color. Fine, elegant, clean and intense aroma. Dry, with a pleasant fruit aftertaste.

## VARIETAL NOTES

“Pinot” comes from the French word for “pinecone” and is given to this grape because it grows in small clusters that resemble the shape of a pinecone. While “Grigio” is derived from the French word “Gris,” meaning “gray” because the grape traditionally has a gray or blue color, although at times it can be more pink or black in appearance. In Italy it is predominately grown in Alto-Adige, Veneto and Friuli.

## FOOD PAIRING

Excellent as aperitif with hors d'oeuvres, seafood salads, fish dishes, with white meats and light meals in general. Chill into the low to mid-40s F – we love ours with grilled and chilled shrimp.
