Prosecco isn't the only dry sparkler to come from Italy. This Spumante, Italian for sparkling, is a viable competitor that drinks far above its price tag. Light yellow color with persistent bubbles. Peach and apple flavors, with an intense influence of white flowers and tropical fruits.
